Thank you for your interest in becoming a team trainer for the Burlington Eagles Hockey Club. Our first priority is to keep our Eagle Players safe and prepared for all practices and games. In order to become a qualified Eagle team trainer you will need to ensure you complete the certifications listed below. 1. Be sure to set up an ehockey account <https://register.hockeycanada.ca/home>
2. Register and Complete these online courses, which once completed, will appear on your hockey profile.
 - Respect in Sport – Activity Leader
 - Gender Identity and Expression Course
 - Vulnerable Sector Check
 - Trainers Level 1
3. **All Eagle trainers are also required to be Level 2 certified- Standard First Aid/CPR/AED.** This is a course you register for outside of OMHA. Once you have completed this course, please upload your proof of course completion to your Spordle account using the link below. From there, the OMHA will upgrade your certification to a Level 2. Certain professions may designate you as having your Level 2 already (ie firefighter, paramedic, nurse etc). Please check with the office on how to upload your Level 2 work credentials.
